


# Patient terminal PAT

#### CAUTION

#### Do not use as rising aid

Cable and device are no rising aid. Do not pull yourself up using the device.

# **Operation**

#### Care staff call

The call button  $\frac{1}{\hbar}$  0 is constantly lit, so that it is easier to locate even in the dark.

#### Call care staff

Press button 1 1.

► The call button ★ 10 lights up.

#### Care staff answers

- Gong sounds over loudspeaker 2 and the call button flashes.
- 2. Use the patient terminal like a telephone for the talk with the care staff.
- 3. The care staff ends the call at the end of the talk.

# Service call

The LED of the button is constantly lit, so that it is easier to locate even in the dark.

Press service call button 🖔 🕖.

► The service call button LED 🖔 🕖 lights up.

The service staff will either call you on the device or will come to you in person.

# Turn light on and off

The LED of the light buttons and are constantly lit, so that the buttons are easier to locate even in the dark.

# **Room light (optional)**

Press the room light button 1 briefly.

▶ Room light is turned on or off.

#### **Reading light (optional)**

Press the reading light button . vi briefly.

► Reading light is turned on or off.

# Menu functions

## Set display brightness

- 1. Press button **MENU 5**.
- Select Brightness on the display (a) using the program selection buttons P+/P- (b).
- Confirm with **OK** button
- 4. Set the desired brightness using -/+ buttons 4.
- 5. Using the menu button **MENU 5** to leave menu.

#### Set display contrast

- Press button MENU 5.
- Select Contrast on the display using the program selection buttons P+/P- ...
- Confirm with **OK** button
- Set the desired contrast using -/+ buttons 4.
- 5. Using the menu button **MENU 5** to leave menu.

#### Set volume

- 1. Press button **MENU 5**.
- Select Volume on the display (3) using the program selection buttons P+/P- (5).
- Confirm with **OK** button
- 4. Select for which function the volume should be set using the program selection buttons **P+/P- 15**.
- 5. Set the desired volume using -/+ buttons 4.
- 6. Using the menu button **MENU** 5 to leave menu.

#### Set ringtone

- 1. Press button **MENU 5**.
- Select Ring tones on the display (a) using the program selection buttons P+/P- (b).
- Confirm with OK button 6.
- 4. Set the desired ring tone using the program selection buttons P+/P- 15.
- 5. Using the menu button **MENU** 5 to leave menu.

# **Optional functions**

#### TV

#### Turn TV set on and off

Press TV button 1 3 to turn the TV set on or off.

► The TV set is turned on and the last channel watched will be indicated on the display 13.

#### **Choosing a channel**

Enter the channel number using the numerical keypad of or switch to the next channel using the program selection buttons P+/P-15.

#### Setting sound and volume

Sound output via the loudspeaker 2 or connected headphones (connection socket 0).

Set the desired volume using -/+ buttons 4.

#### Call up teletext

- Press teletext button to call up or leave teletext mode.
- Enter the page number using the numerical keypad or switch to the next page using the program selection buttons P+/P- .

# Radio

#### Turn radio on and off

Press radio button 1 2 to turn the radio on or off.

► The radio is turned on and the last radio channel listened towill be indicated on the display <a>®</a>.

#### Choosing a channel

Enter the channel number using the numerical keypad of or switch to the next channel using the program selection buttons P+/P-15.

#### Setting sound and volume

Sound output via the loudspeaker 2 or connected headphones (connection socket 0).

Set the desired volume using -/+ buttons 4.

# **Telephone**

#### Accept a call

- Set the desired volume using -/+ buttons 4.

#### Making a telephone call

- Press numerical key for trunk line/public switched telephone network (usually 0, please check with the staff).
- Call the desired telephone number using the numerical keypad 6.
- 4. Confirm with **OK** button **16**.

#### Last number redial

- The last ten dialled telephone numbers are indicated on the display 13.
- 3. Select the desired number using -/+ buttons 4.
- Confirm with **OK** button **6**.
- Press the telephone button to end the call after the conversation.

## **Blinds control**

- Press special functions button 
   \( \bar{\pi} \)
   \( \bar{\pi} \)
- 2. Select **Blinds** on the display **19** using the program selection buttons **P+/P-19**.
- Open or close the blinds using the -/+ buttons 4.

## Infrared receiver

The infrared receiver is used to remotely control the patient terminal via environmental control devices.

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
